- Did you know that our Town Council have been working on a Neighbourhood Plan since 2015?
- It's supposed to be a community led document building consensus and vision for the town.
- It should include policies for the biggest development the Lanes has ever seen - called SS6 - at least 100 dwellings between Lower Pennington Lane and Ridgeway Lane.
- The threat to the Lanes doesn't stop at SS6 - We've found out that another Green Belt site on the other side of Lower Pennington Lane is now being promoted for another large housing estate.
- We think the community should have a say but The Town Council won't talk to PALLS – only to developers and landowner. So we're presenting them with our..

- **Creation of a Safer Lanes Network.**

- **Protection of Ditches and Verges for Wildlife and Biodiversity and to control flooding.**
- **Promoting Dark Skies and controls on light pollution.**
- **Retaining and enhancing mature trees and hedgerows.**
- **Resist the widening or straightening of the lanes or development which would lead to rat-running.**
